into the Château of Prince and Princess de Broglie

Dominating the Loire, in a cultural landscape inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List, Château of Chaumont-sur-Loire is one of the most remarkable of the Loire Valley Châteaux. Owned by Queen Catherine de' Medici in the 16th century, and then by her rival Diane de Poitiers, it has welcomed scores of famous names throughout its history, including Nostradamus, the sculptor Jean-Baptiste Nini, Benjamin Franklin and Germaine de Staël. It enjoyed an intense period of prestige and festivities in the late 19th century, when Prince and Princess de Broglie infused it with an extraordinary spirit of modernity.

A HISTORIC CHÂTEAU WITH A FESTIVE SPIRIT

Once you've crossed the drawbridge, you are immersed in history. You get to discover how the princely couple transformed the Château to make it comfortable (electricity, running water and central heating) and worthy of the greatest receptions imaginable. As you make your way from room to room, you can admire gothic chests, splendid tapestries and rare pieces of furniture. So many outstanding items that continue to uphold the Château's reputation.

GROUNDS WITH OUTSTANDING VIEWPOINTS

Overlooking the Loire, the Historic Grounds (42 acres) are another of the Domain's wonders. Designed by the architect and landscaper Henri Duchêne, these English-style grounds include a system of curvilinear pathways that take in a series of magnificent viewpoints, now marked out by comfortable seats where visitors can rest awhile and contemplate the landscape.

INTERNATIONAL GARDEN FESTIVAL

One of the Domain of Chaumont-sur-Loire's emblematic events, the International Garden Festival perpetuates a tradition of knowhow and whimsy started 150 years ago by Prince and Princess de Broglie, the Château's last private owners. Dedicated to creation, imagination, poetry and nature, each year the event brings together designers from throughout the world around a single theme.

GARDENS OF CREATION

A mine of ideas as well as a nursery for up and coming talents, the world-renowned Festival breathes new energy into the art of gardens. For six months at a time, new blooms and materials, alongside innovative ideas and approaches, fascinate public and professionals alike as they come to admire the gardens/creations and draw inspiration from them. Five "green" carte blanche are also given to top names in landscaping, design, art, and [why not?] philosophy!

THE PRÉS DU GOULOUPE, GARDENS CONNECTED WITH THE GREAT GARDEN CIVILISATIONS

Stretching alongside the Festival, the *Prés du Gouloupe* comprise 28 acres of nature accommodating permanent gardens, artworks, and plant collections. As they make their way along landscaped pathways, visitors can acquaint themselves with the great garden civilisations as interpreted by internationally famous contemporary landscapers and, depending on the season, admire such features as the arch of old roses, the flowerbeds of dahlias and peonies, the canopies of star jasmine and the collections of asters and clematis...

Take a gentle stroll through the 80-acre park, where shaded gardens, the freshness of water, and rich plant life offer a moment of lightness and connection with nature.

Acting as a natural bridge between plants and gardens, and between horticultural heritage and landscape design, this unique Plant Festival will give you the chance to discover the star plants of the International Garden Festival at the exhibitors' stands.

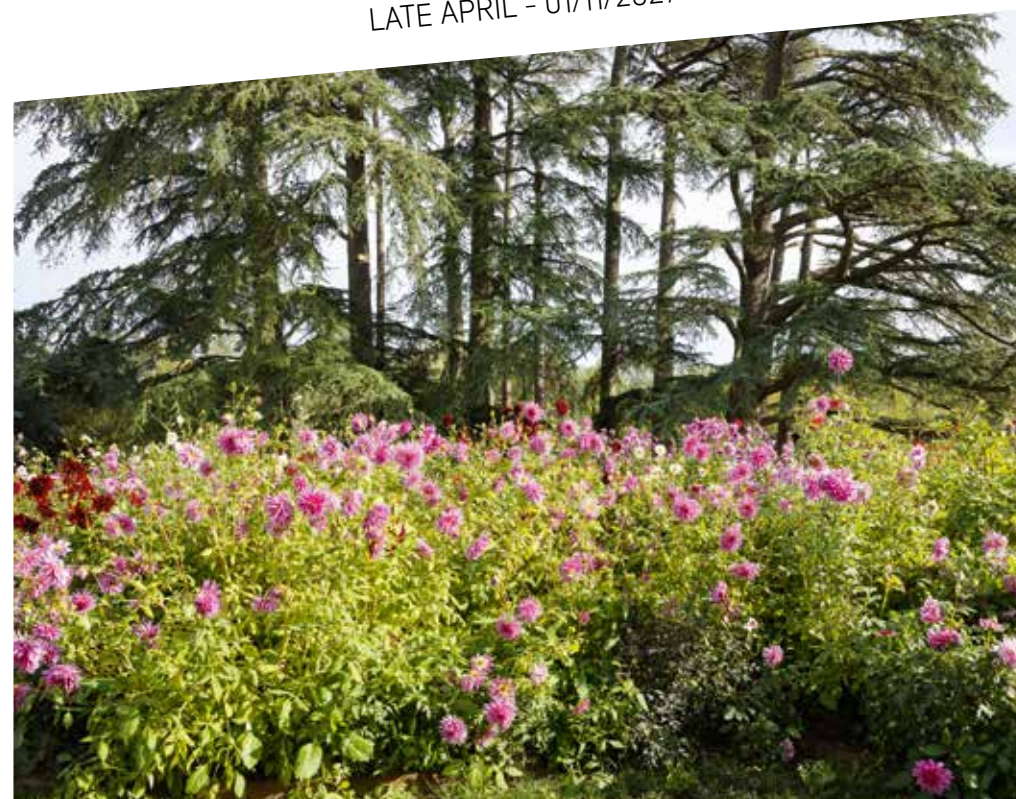

ART SEASON

Every year, the Arts and Nature Centre invites visual artists and photographers to create and exhibit original works with nature as their theme. Displayed across the Domain's 32 hectares, the results provide visitors with an initiatory itinerary rich in discoveries and emotion. In keeping with the concept of the "right place", they are on view in the Château and its outbuildings as well as in the Historic Grounds. Great names on the international scene and lesser known creators alike, over 200 contemporary artists and photographers have already entered into complicit dialogue with the site.

WORKS ON VIEW ALL YEAR ROUND

Alongside the Art Season's and Chaumont-Photo-sur-Loire's exhibitions, the Domain possesses a collection of works on view all year round, partly composed of special commissions by the Centre-Val de Loire Region and partly of permanent installations. El Anatsui, Andy Goldsworthy, Sheila Hicks, Eva Jospin, Wang Keping, Gabriel Orozco, Giuseppe Penone and Sarkis are just a few of the artists whose works are on permanent exhibition.

A UNIQUE VIEWPOINT ON LANDSCAPE AND NATURE

Every year, Chaumont-Photo-sur-Loire offers an opportunity to discover the Domain's commitment to beauty and respect for nature through images. The event, which runs from mid-November to the end of February, features several simultaneous exhibitions by both internationally renowned artists and emerging talents.

MAX ERNST - DE NATURA - 17 October 2026 – 28 February 2027

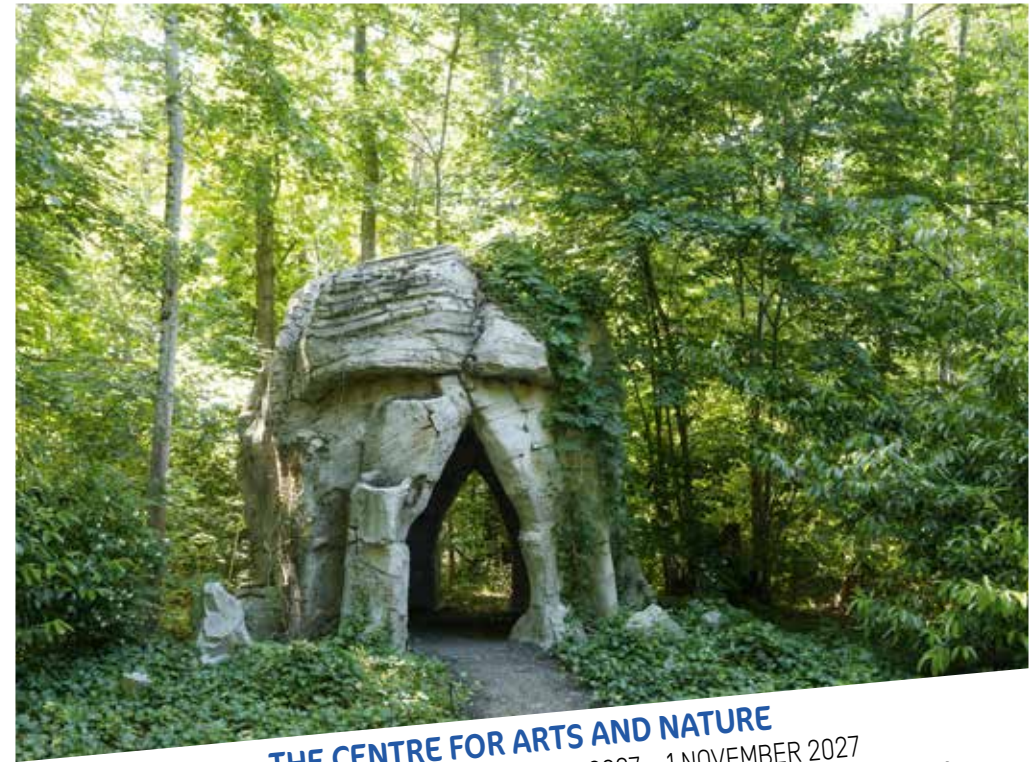
Presented as part of the AR(t)CHIPEL festival, born out of a partnership between the Centre Pompidou and the Centre-Val de Loire region, De Natura showcases a selection of works that transform nature into a language. 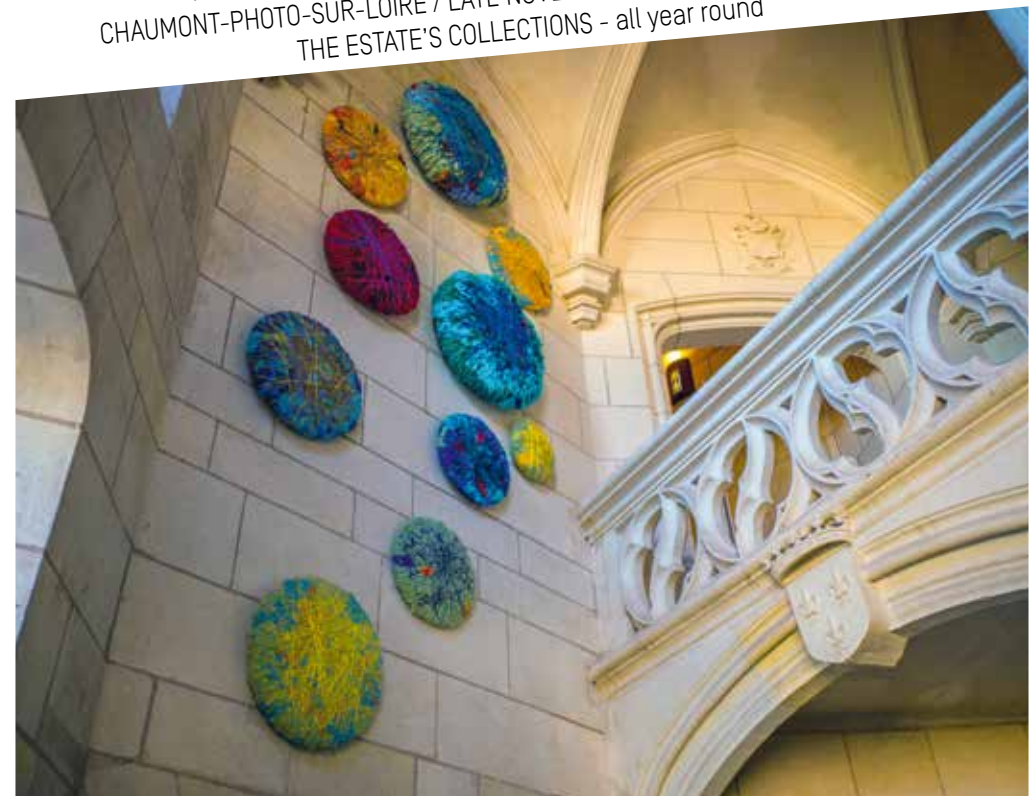

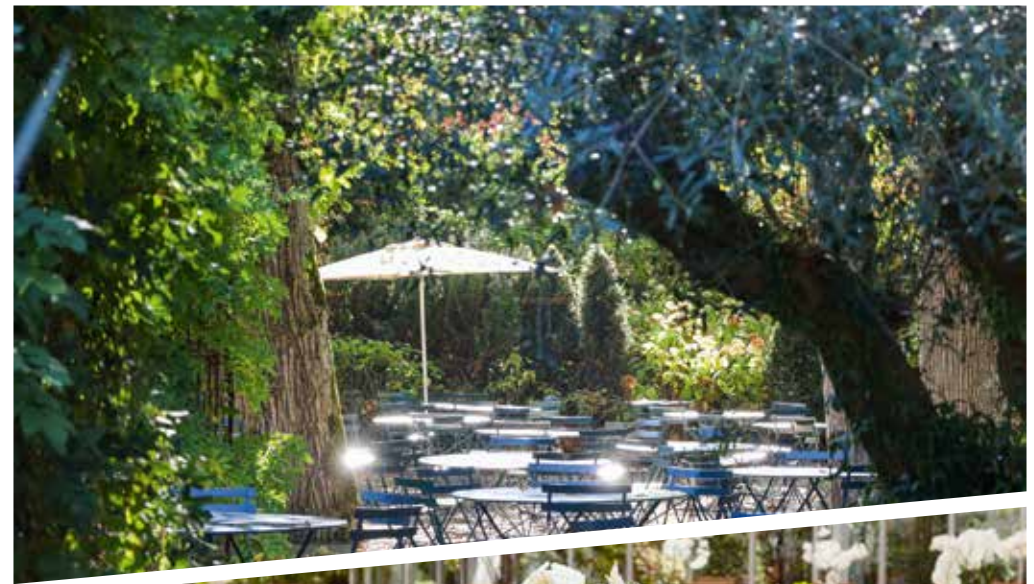

Resulting from the restoration of a former farm alongside contemporary architectural creation, the hotel comprises **39 atypical rooms** with universes of refinement and simplicity.

Poetic and resolutely unconventional, the hotel cultivates a spirit of creation, encouraging reading, cultural discovery and exchanges, and resisting any temptation to standardise emotions and sensations.


